Allé Banner Stand™ - AP Series

- 1. Starting with a clean floor/surface, spread the graphic on the floor. Place the base next to the bottom of the graphic (the end without a zipper). Align the narrow part of the base with the wide part of the graphic. Slide the base into the bottom of the graphic. Once the base is inside the graphic, rotate the base so that the wide part of the base aligns with the wide part of the graphic. Hold the graphic in place with one hand and use the openings of the base for your other hand to pull the base to the edge of the bottom of the graphic, so that the elastic ring of the graphic rests on the bottom edge of the base. Stand the base upright.
- 2. Unzip and spread open the top of the graphic, so that the stem of the base is visible. Find the first straight upright section with the oval hole at the bottom (A). Connect that tube to the base by depressing the base's spring button and sliding the pole over the base stem, lining the oval hole up with the spring button.
- 3. Find the 2 tube sections which have a round hole at the bottom and a spring button at the top (B). Attach these to the pole from step 2.
- 4. Place the last straight tube (C), which has no spring button at the top, on top of the tubes from step 3.
- 5. Assemble the top crossbar (if needed) by aligning the spring button in the crossbar with the hole in the crossbar, and place atop the assembled upright.
- 6. Carefully pull the graphic over the top crossbar and zip the graphic closed at the top. If this is difficult, make sure there isn't excess graphic material stuck under the base. It may also be helpful to have someone pull the two sides of the graphic together as you zip it closed.
