## Traditional Easel<sup>™</sup> - 1400

- 1. Rotate crossbars on back leg support so that notch is facing upwards.
- 2. Lay center upright face down. Attach back leg support by sliding carriage bolts into center upright channel and tightening.
- 3. Lay side legs face down and latch the top of the legs together as shown below.
- 4. Attach back leg support to side legs with wingnuts.
- 5. Stand up easel. Attach bottom canvas tray by sliding the knob-glide screw down side channel legs and tightening. Be sure to attach the knob-glide screws to the tray first if they are not already attached. 5-A: It is easiest to first attach the knob to the glide screw. 5-B: Pass the glide screw through the slot of the bottom canvas tray. 5-C: Hold the tray in a diagonal position with the triangular edge facing upward, then insert the glide screw of the lower end into the first upright channel. 5-D: Keep the tray in a diagonal position, then slide the glide screw of the other end of the tray, into the channel of the second upright. 5-E: Adjust the tray to a horizontal orientation, then slide the tray to the desired height location on the uprights. Tighten the knobs.
- **6.6-A:** Attach metal feet to frame holder and utility tray then, **6-B:** slide into support channel and tighten.
